The show is directed by Lesley Hart, whose previous credits with BOS include The Pajama Game and Calamity Jane, with our fifteen piece orchestra under the command of Ricardo Gonzalez our regular Musical Director. Our Maria was easy to find in the form of Lucy Russell with Kevin Vaughan-Smith as Captain von Trapp. And, of course, then there are the seven von Trapp children! So many really talented youngsters auditioned for these parts that we've picked a double cast, each of whom will appear in alternate performances. You'll have to come twice to see them all! This show will be popular so you are urged to book your tickets early to avoid disappointment.

Please note that the performance on Tues 27th is a preview Charity Night. All tickets are only £10 and the proceeds of the evening will be shared with Chiltern Samaritans. Please do support this very worthy local charity.

Seating at The Curzon Centre will be a combination of two styles so as to satisfy all tastes. At the front will be cabaret-style seating around tables so you can enjoy drinks during the performance and snacks at the interval. However, please note that all drinks must be purchased from the bar.
